

DOLOR

DOLOR is the verb, in the infinitive form for **PAIN**. **DOLOR** is also a 'reflexive verb', which means that the action is 'happening to the person or thing'.

The main forms of **DOLOR** are as follows:

- Me duele
- Me duelen
- Te duele
- Te duelen
- Le duele
- Le duelen
- Nos duelen
- Les duelen

Some examples are as follows:

- Me duele la cabeza. I HAVE A HEADACHE.
- Me duelen los ojos. MY EYES HURT.
- ¿Te duele el pecho? DOES YOUR CHEST HURT? (primarily used in question form)
- ¿Te duelen las piernas? DO YOUR LEGS HURT? (primarily used in question form)
- Le duele la espalda. HIS/HER BACK HURTS. (a name can be used instead of his/her)
- Le duelen los dientes. HIS/HER TEETH HURT. (a name can be used instead of his/her)
- Nos duelen los cuellos. OUR NECKS HURT. (always in plural form)
- Les duelen los pies. THEIR FEET HURT. (always in plural form)
